Administrative Order:


By letter dated September 25, 2017, counsel for defendant Bilal Hashmat (Bilal) requests that this action be reassigned from I.A.S. Part 43 (Reed, J.) to the Commercial Division. No response to the request has been received.

This alleged shareholder derivative action was properly assigned to Justice Robert Reed as related to Iman Kamal, as Administratrix of the Estate of Kamal Hashmat v. CureMD.com, Inc., Index No. 651956/2017 (the Promissory Note Action) and Iman Kamal, as Administratrix of the Estate of Kamal Hashmat v. Bilal Hashmat, et al., Index No. 652710/2017 (the CureMD.com, Inc. Share Ownership Declaratory Judgment Action), two actions pending in this court that have been assigned to Justice Reed. A review of the complaint in this third action underscores that it is closely related to, and has its genesis in, a dispute among members of the Hashmat family over the ownership and management of CureMed.Com, Inc. since the death of Bilal's brother, Kamal Hashmat, in 2014. Therefore, judicial economy is served by having the three actions assigned to the same justice.

For these reasons, the defendant's request to assign this case to the Commercial Division is denied.
