By letter dated August 2, 2019, Adam Pollock, Esq., counsel for plaintiff, requests that this action be assigned to the Commercial Division pursuant to Uniform Rule 202.70.

This action was commenced on June 5, 2019. On July 31, 2019, defendants filed a motion to dismiss the complaint. Defendants' counsel filed an RJ1, but did not file a Commercial Division addendum, and the case was therefore assigned to a General Part (Hon. Francis A. Kahn III).

Upon review, the court agrees that this application is timely and that the action meets the standards for assignment of cases to the Commercial Division (see, Uniform Rule 202.70[a]).

Accordingly, the request for assignment to the Commercial Division is granted. The General Clerk's office is directed to transfer this action from IAS Part 14 (Kahn, J) and randomly assign it to a Justice of the Commercial Division.
