**ADMINISTRATIVE
ORDER**


By letter dated July 24, 2019, David E. Ross, Esq., counsel for defendants, requests that this action be assigned to the Commercial Division pursuant to Uniform Rule 202.70. Counsel states that he has conferred with counsel for plaintiff, who has indicated that he does not object to the transfer of this case to the Commercial Division.

This action seeks damages for breach of contract and related causes of action. Damages are claimed in the amount of \$750,000. The summons and complaint were filed on April 23, 2019, and the pleadings were served on May 22, 2019. Plaintiff filed an RJL on July 15, 2019. Since plaintiff filed only the RJL and did not file a Commercial Division addendum, the action was assigned to a General Part (Nock, J).

Defendants promptly and timely filed this letter application to the Administrative Judge and have satisfactorily demonstrated that the action falls within the standards for assignment of cases to the Commercial Division (see, Uniform Rule 202.70[a]).

Accordingly, the request for assignment to the Commercial Division is granted. The General Clerk's office is directed to transfer this action from Part 38 (Nock, J) and randomly reassign it to a Justice of the Commercial Division.
